



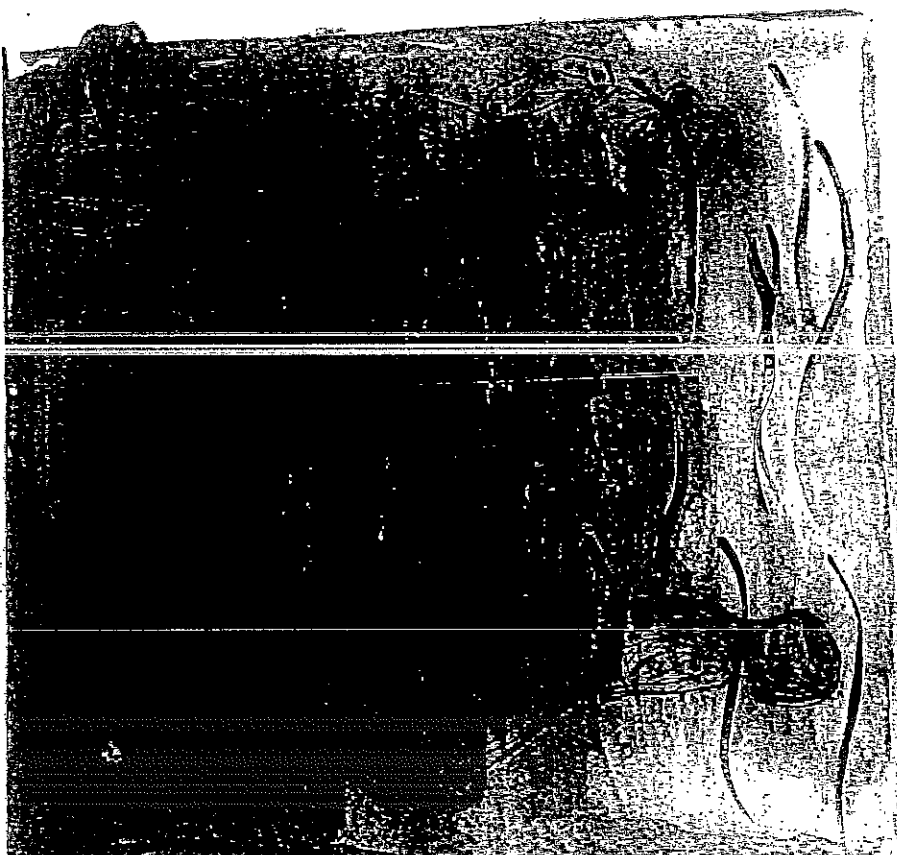
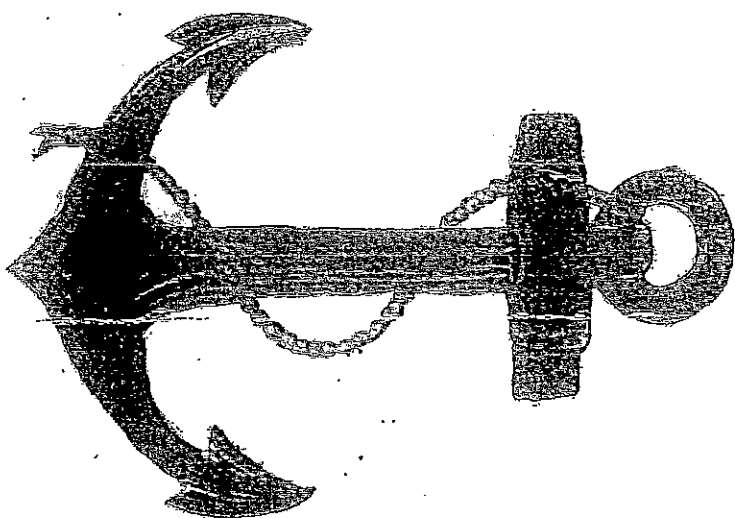
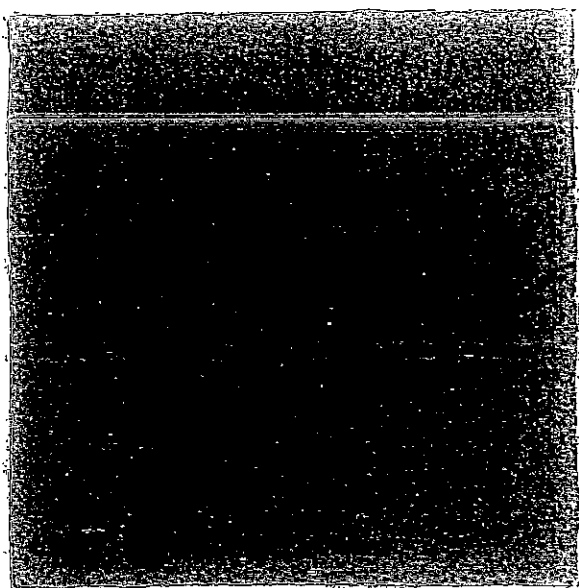
## CSI Response

# Examples of body language



Cadet Grey is a mix of a light grey and a hint of blue. I chose this colour to represent Avalon because in the start of the book, she was strongly opposed to leaving Grace Point but over the course of school holidays she became more interested in the opportunities and the new modern school at Perth. The blue in this mix for a colour represents her excitement and curiosity of the change that is about to happen in the book. It also represents her short lived happiness. However the more dominant colour, the grey in cadet grey represents her misery, sadness, curiosity, loss, rejection and depression after the change in the book. It takes a hold of her life and grips it tighter and tighter with each thing that occurs.

I chose this image to represent Avalon's depression. Constantly throughout the book after the change and after her loss, Avalon had plenty of moments where her depression was up in her face and blocked out everything else. The girl in the middle of this image represents Avalon at her worst, feeling like she is overwhelmed, not good enough, engulfed and is a conflicted and different item to society. The bubbles and water in this image represent that Avalon is drowning in her thoughts and depression. The two girls beside the girl in the middle represent that they are happy and can breathe around Avalon, who cannot. They also represent the upright, fake, perfect, horrible characters in the book that bully Avalon.

I chose this anchor and rope to symbolise Avalon because of the events that happen in her life. After the change in the book, Avalon experiences and goes through many horrific things and as a result of, she is caught up in this situation. She is often weighed down by the pressures of society and struggles to plant both of her feet back on the ground. The anchor symbolises her depression and loss as it continually tries to pull and sink her down in the depths of her despair and thoughts. The top half of the rope symbolises her situation of how she is tied up at the head of the moment and feeling very helpless, vulnerable and ultimately trapped. The other half of the rope which at the end is cut off represents Avalon taking control of her situation and freeing herself by finally ignoring the bullies and society and then seeking help from her parents who help stop the bullies.
